



Scorekeeper Policy

Thanks for participating in the score keeper program for the St. Romans Athletic Association. The following information highlights the general policies for this program.

Age Requirements:

All score keepers must be in the 9th grade or higher. No middle school or grade school students are allowed to keep score.

Schedule:

Games will be scheduled on an evenly rotated basis among the people that have signed up to work. Schedules are created by the Athletic Board and coordinated by the Score Keeper Coordinator. It is the responsibility of the score keeper to find a replacement if they cannot make a scheduled game. This change must also be reported to the coordinator.

General Requirements:

The following requirements must be met or the score keeper forfeits their rights to be a score keeper.

- The scorekeeper's family **MUST** be an active member of St. Romans Church and the scorekeeper must be part of the Religious Education program (if applicable)
- The scorekeeper must make a commitment to uphold Christian attitudes and values in all athletic related endeavors (both on and off the court)
- The scorekeeper **MUST arrive 15 minutes prior** to a scheduled shift. If a scorekeeper is late on more than 2-3 occasions they will not be able to score for the remainder of the season and may not be allowed to be on the roster for the next season
- The score keeper must be able to score for a minimum of 3 games (if applicable)
- There must be **ABSOLUTELY no texting or phone calls during games**
- The scorekeeper **MUST** arrange for a replacement if they are unable to make their commitment (and also contact the coordinator of the change). If the scorekeeper or their replacement does not show up for their time slot on more than 2 occasions they will not be able to score keep for the remainder of the season and may not be allowed to be on the roster for the next season. **It is your responsibility to find a replacement.**
- The scorekeeper needs to clean up after yourself – no trash left behind

Note: You will be removed from the program if you fail to follow any of the above guidelines.

Benefits:

This is a paid position and the pay scale as follows:

- Scorekeeper:
 - \$7.00 per game (1st & 2nd year)
 - \$8.00 per game (3rd year +)

Scorekeepers are paid by the game and not time (therefore, if the game goes into overtime or is delayed there is no additional payment).

Scorekeepers are allowed 1 beverage and 1 food item per shift. A shift includes 3 games.

Scorekeeper Coordinator:

The responsibility of the coordinator is as follows:

- Develop a schedule for all league and tournament games (see notes under schedule)
- Post the schedule in the concession area – schedule to include name of score keeper and contact information (home phone / cell phone)

Tournament Games:

The tournament games for St. Romans are scheduled as follows:

- 7th Grade Boys & Girls January 23rd – 26th
- 8th Grade Boys February 20th – 22nd Girls
- 8th Grade Girls February 27th, 28th and March 2nd
- 6th Grade Boys and Girls March 6th – 9th
